HeART for the Bay

On May 6, 2026, the Oro Loma Sanitary District celebrated local students for their creativity and environmental leadership during the 2026 HeART for the Bay Awards Dinner. The annual contest invited K-12 students to explore the theme “Love Our Bay” through original artwork and videos highlighting sustainability, recycling, and everyday actions that help protect the San Francisco Bay.

This year, the District received 65 submissions from students throughout its service area, with 19 students recognized as contest winners during the event.



Collection System of the Year

Oro Loma Sanitary District was honored with the 2025–26 Statewide Collection System of the Year Award in the Medium category on April 10, 2026. Presented by the California Water Environment Association, the award recognizes the outstanding work of the District’s Collection System Team and their dedication to protecting public health and the environment through proactive maintenance, emergency response, regulatory compliance, safety, and daily field operations that keep the community’s sewer system running reliably.



An Update on the Districting Process

In January 2026, the Oro Loma Sanitary District initiated the transition from at-large elections to district-based elections for its Board of Directors following the adoption of a resolution of intent. After a multi-month public process that included community outreach, public hearings, and opportunities for map submissions and feedback, the Board officially adopted new voting district maps in May 2026.

District-based elections establish geographic voting areas that determine how Board members are elected. The transition does not affect District services, operations, collection schedules, or service levels.
